# Attainment

## Exam Results - 2017

- 62% of S4 pupils achieved 5+ National 5s
- 26% of S5 pupils achieved 5 Highers
- 44% of S6 pupils achieved 5 Highers

## Positive Destinations

- Approximately 60% go on to Higher Education
- Approximately 20% go on to Further Education
- Approximately 20% go on to Employment/Training



# Inspection - May 2015

The following key strengths were identified by Education Scotland -

- The welcoming, inclusive environment created by staff and articulate, polite young people.
- Young people's enthusiasm for music and the impact this has on the ethos of the school.
- Approaches to engage parents in improving young people's learning.
- The well co-ordinated approaches involving staff and partners working together to improve outcomes for young people who require additional support.

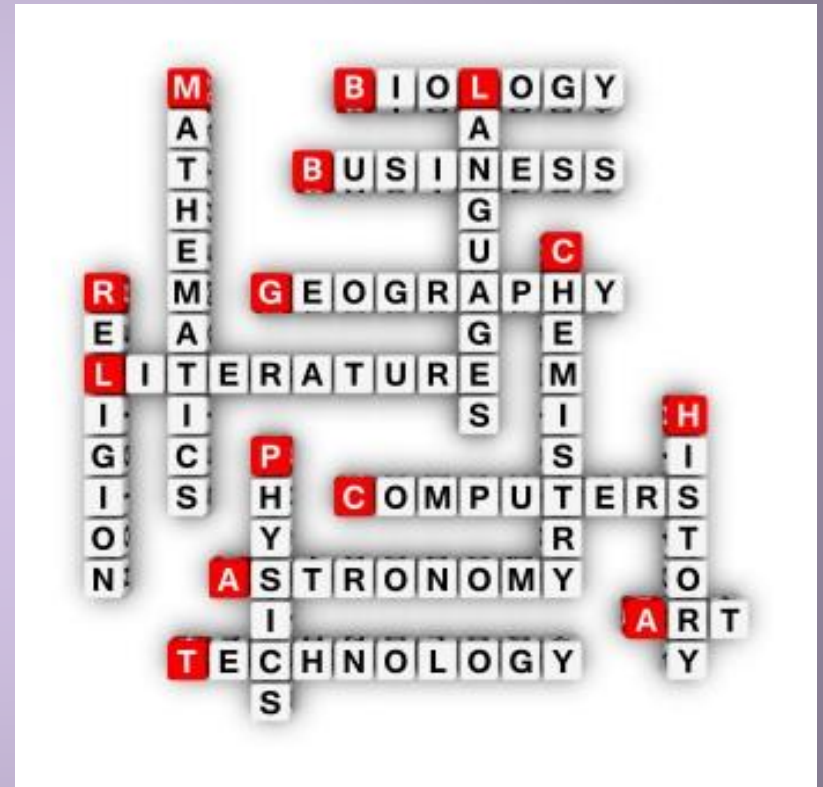

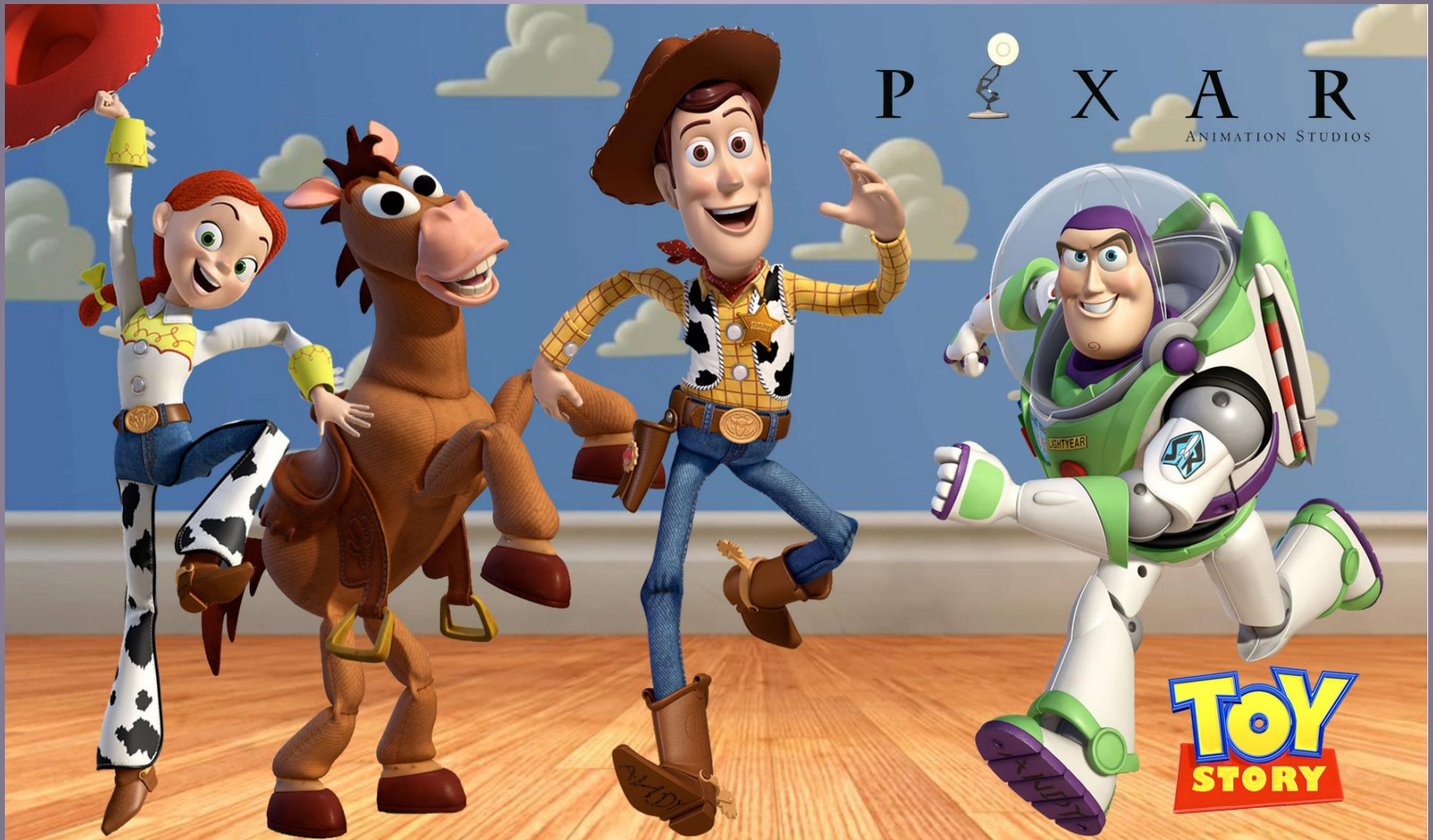
